Colorado Parks and Wildlife Ranch Shooting Range, U-19-001

Please accept the following comments from El Paso County Public Health for the project referenced above:

- Earthmoving activity in excess of one acre, but less than twenty-five acres, requires a local Construction Activity Permit from El Paso County Public Health. Go to https://www.elpasocountyhealth.org/service/air-quality/construction-activity-application for more information. Earthmoving activities greater than 25 acres require a Construction Activity Permit from the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Air Pollution Control Division. Go to: https://www.colorado.gov/pacific/cdphe/general-air-permits
- No water or wastewater service plans were included with the submittal review materials.
- If a water system is planned for the shooting range, then it must comply with the requirements of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE), Water Quality Control Division (WQCD).
- If an onsite wastewater treatment system (OWTS) is planned for the shooting range, then it must be sized and designed by a Colorado Registered Professional Engineer. NOTE: Portable toilets are for temporary use only.
