- If the proposed equipment does not use one of the pre-approved frequency bands contained in the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) [Antenna System Co-Location Policy](https://www.faa.gov/oa/external/portal.jsp), the applicant is to file an airspace evaluation case with the FAA for the purposes of a frequency analysis and provide the results to the Airport before the commencement of construction activities.
