My wife and I are opposed to the development of this large commercial structure, Buc-EEs, anywhere on the I-25 and County Line Road intersection. We are long-time (since 2007) north Woodmoor residents. We originally moved to this area because of the wide-open spaces and abundance of nature/wildlife. If we wanted the opposite, we would've moved to the Denver or Colorado Springs Metro areas. Here on the Palmer Divide, we are a residential development with significant space between homes (generally ranging from one-half to several acre lots).
