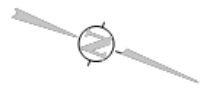
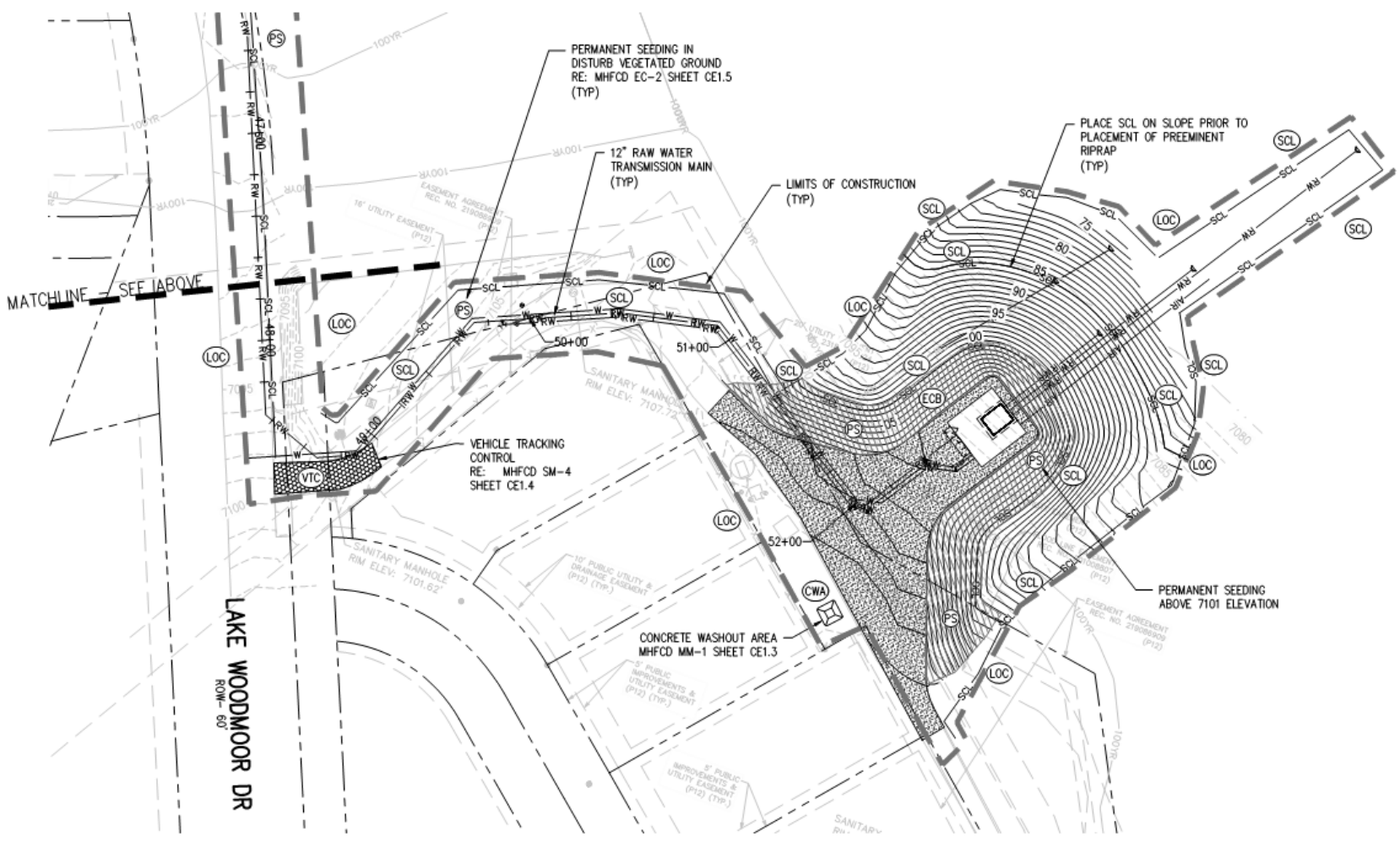

A: Permanent seeding, as required and detailed on the construction documents and approved in our storm water management plan using perennial grasses

A: Fill material free of rocks greater than 6" in the upper 18" of fill. Compaction of fill sheeps foot and jumping jack near accessories

A: Dust control watering will be completed as needed and monitored by the onsite supervisor. Water readily accessible throughout the duration of the project.

Q: If chemical stabilizers are to be in use, explain (include frequency and location on map)

A: NONE.

Q: Describe how steep slopes will be controlled (detail location on map)

A: At Lake Pump Station, steep slope has an erosion control blanket and SCL's during construction. Permanent seeding and riprap protection are permanent measures to be left in place at the completion of construction activities.

A: N/A

A: The project has a net FILL. The small amount of cut to be re-used for suitable backfilled will be stored onsite with BMP protection, the duration of the project intends to utilize the material within 60-days.
