Re: Water Service to Front Range-Midway Solar Project

Dear Sir or Madam:

The Front-Range-Midway Solar Project has purchased three water taps within the Comanche/Wigwam decreed water service area. The Wigwam Mutual Water Company (Wigwam), a consumer owned utility, under public water system ID# CO 0121470 will deliver potable water to the solar project according to the By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of Wigwam, as may be amended from time to time; Decreed Augmentation Plans; and as allowed by the State Water Engineer. Wigwam's water rights are understood to be "renewable" water resources under the El Paso County 300-year water supply rules. Water is pumped from the Fountain Creek Alluvial Aquifer by commercial wells and treated by filters and chlorination at Wigwam's treatment plants according to EPA Standards.
