Federal Aviation Administration Process

The United States Air Force Academy (USAFA) is passing along instructions to assist the applicant in conducting the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) review process for this proposed development under Title 14, Part 77 of the Code of Federal Regulations. Due to the proximity of this development to the airfield, the FAA will likely require a review of this project to determine if the finished structure or any associated construction cranes will impact the operations and safety of an airport. The FAA process affords other users of the airspace, such as the military, the opportunity to provide their input on potential impacts and mitigations. Then, the FAA issues a final determination. Please follow the instructions below to begin a review with the FAA.

- Instructions for how to determine if a full aeronautical study is required are on the main page
 - Select the “click here” sections for e-filing a 7460-1 Request for Construction or Alteration, for temporary and permanent structures located OFF or ON airport property.
- Once the review has been completed, please forward a copy of the results to the project planner and to USAFA Community Planning (see email below).
 - The final review page should show no further study is required, or the aeronautical study review number.
