We are in the process of designing phase I to begin construction this summer and intend to add phase II at a later date that will then accommodate all grades, K-12. The initial phase includes classrooms for 450 students. When the second phase is completed, it will house a total of only 702 students in all grades. The school is designed to be small enough to foster a family atmosphere for our neighbors in this part of our community. LTA will offer a Traditional American Education in a respectful, orderly environment.

3. The school being proposed is shown in the attached drawings. There will be one 2-story building, approximately 34,500 square feet in size in Phase I and an additional 11,700 square feet in Phase II added in future potential construction. Aside from classrooms, there are playgrounds, a parking lot, and multi-use gym/cafeteria/performance auditorium.

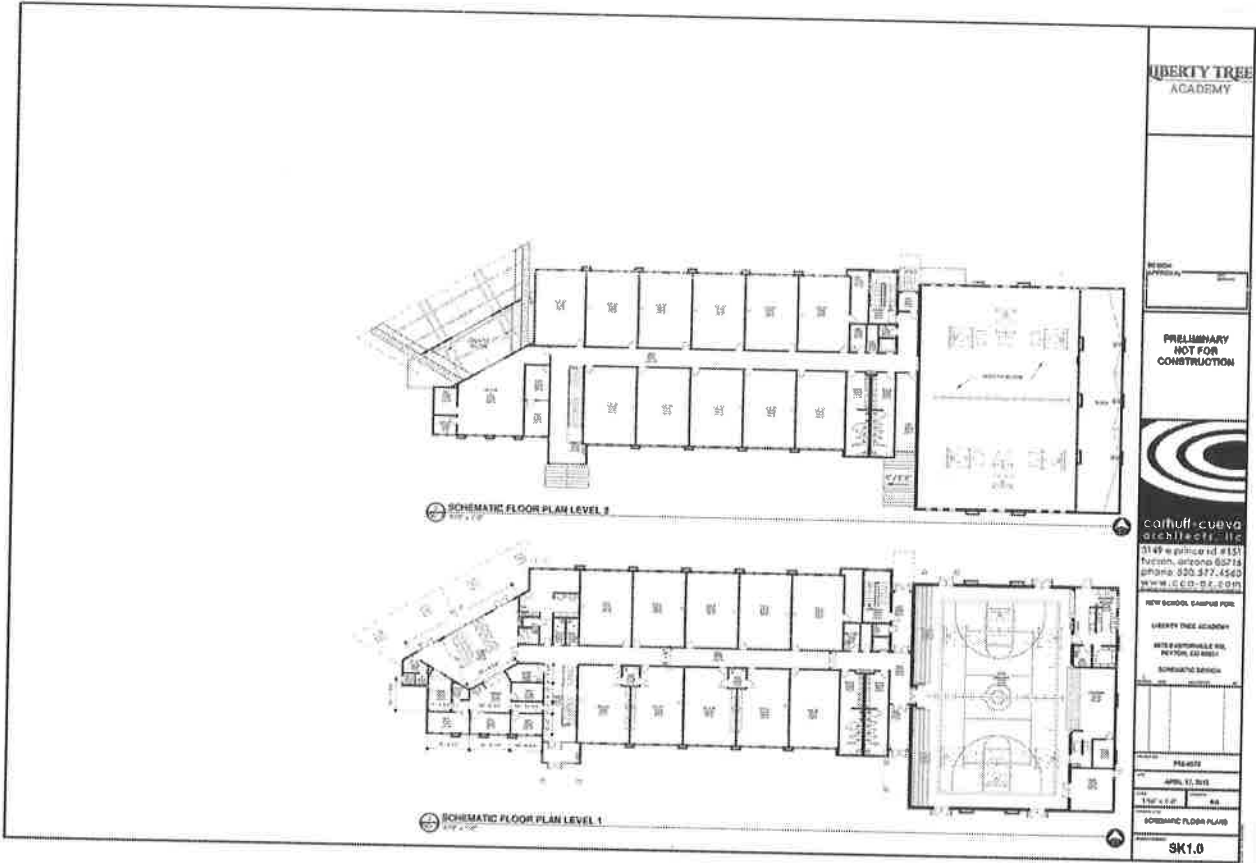

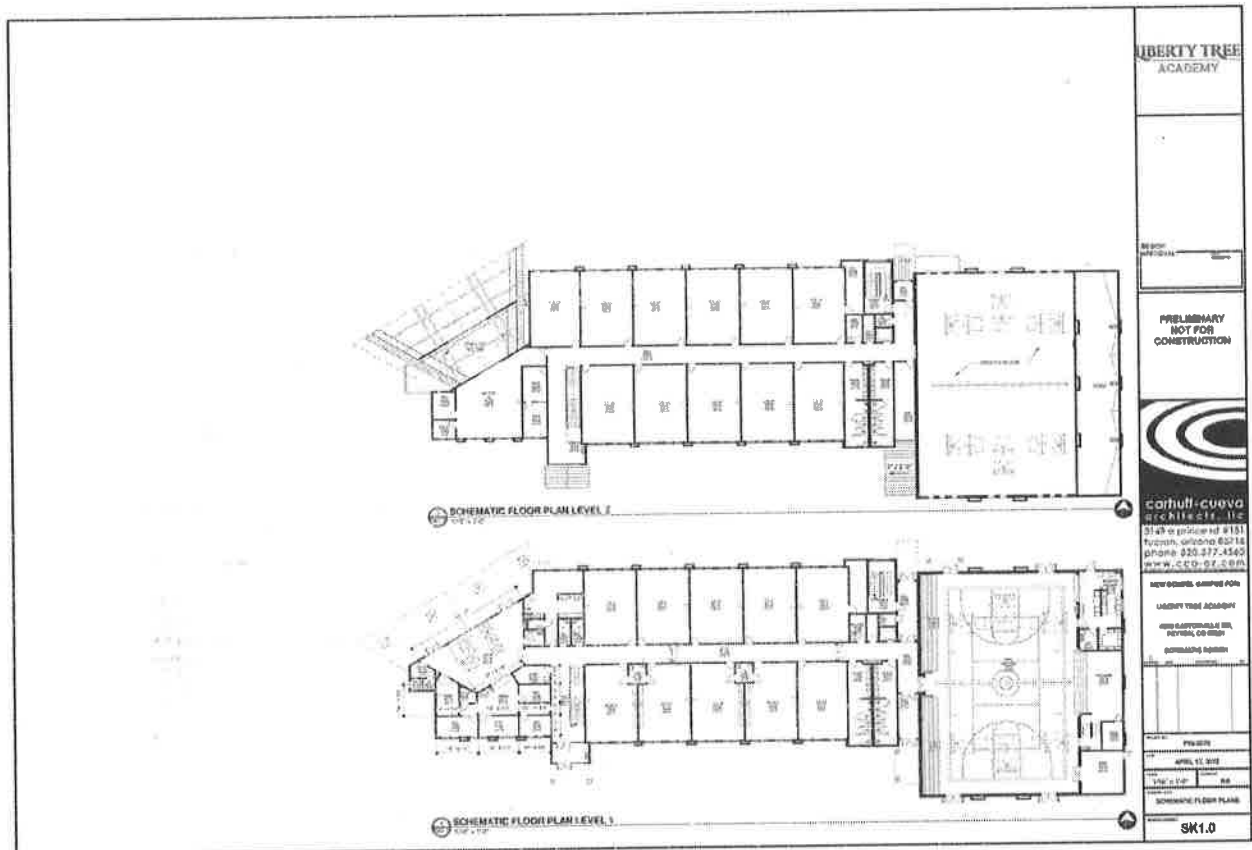
