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Dear Ms Darden,

We have become aware that there is a request for a special use permit by the above referenced applicant in our neighborhood. Our parcel is described as 13000-00-575 and we are close to this property.

We are concerned that if a special use permit for the parcel would be granted, that it could be transferred to another type of animal raising if the rodent farm doesn't work out. Is it possible that it could be used for raising a high concentration of other livestock such as cattle or hogs on such a small acreage without public input?

Another concern is how the waste generated by this many rodents and the bedding cleaned from their cages twice a week will be disposed of. It can't possibly be dumped somewhere on the property. The high winds that we routinely have would blow it on to neighboring properties. If the plan is to bury it on the property, then all of the wells in the nearby area would be at risk for contamination.

It is our sincerest request that the application for a livestock feed yard in our neighborhood be denied. We bought our property years ago and have been making improvements since that time. We enjoy the amenities of rural life and would like to see the uses for the neighboring land kept to small family farms and ranches consistent to what is now in the existing neighborhood,
