Following the completion of the final drainage report it was confirmed by Baseline Engineering that the Orton Pit will not retain water following completion of the project, will convey all storm drainage in the same pattern that the existing drainage follows, and will not require any permanent stormwater facilities.

Following conversations with Daniel Torres from El Paso County Planning & Community Development, it was confirmed that no detention maintenance agreement would be required for the proposed pit if permanent stormwater facilities were not included in our final drainage report findings.
