That's great news – thank you for attempting to make the requested changes. I agree, the Colorado Cattlemen's Agricultural Land Trust doesn't need to be listed in the conservation easements section.

For page 10 (formerly page 8 for the first version), I think the sketch you sent is accurate. Attached is a screen capture from the CSLB website – it appears to match your sketch. Yes, the large lots area shown on the map and in your sketch to the west of Schriever AFB and Curtis Road has always been accurately depicted (pardon me if I created any confusion there).

If possible, hoping the team can take a look at Page 121 (formerly page 119 for the first version), State and Federal Lands map. Just hoping it lines up with the changes that will be shown on page 10.

I know this has been a really big undertaking, so really appreciate all of your outreach and patience throughout the process. Thank you again for considering our comments.
