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Good morning, Ryan – attached is a copy of engineering staff's review comments (<u>Fifth</u> Submittal) we downloaded this morning from EDARP for **Saddlehorn Ranch** <u>Filing 2</u> **Final Plat**. We highlighted the few items that may trigger yet a Sixth Submittal. These last few comments appear to be either "new" or appear redundant between reviewers (e.g., see the items pertaining to the mail kiosk). Our own project engineer (JR Engineering) personally met with engineering staff on 01/22/23 [see their email copied below] to review the last round of comments and had come to a mutual agreement on how to address them – but we are still receiving new comments.

We have directed JR Engineering and LSC Traffic Consultants to follow-up with Jeff Rice/Charlene Durham immediately and to walk-through their responses for remaining items; we cannot afford another 14-21 day staff review cycle for a Sixth Resubmittal.

As we shared with you previously our client for Saddlehorn is in a holding pattern and cannot close on lots in Filing 2 without an approved Final Plat. Our client also cannot close on an \$11M bond issuance for Saddlehorn infrastructure and faces penalties with investors until the Filing 2 Final Plat is approved and recorded. Saddlehorn Filings 3 and 4 Final Plats have been submitted to EDARP for review and the submittal of Filing 5 is imminent. We cannot afford a repeat of what we're experiencing with Fil. 2.

Ryan, you have always been very helpful and responsive to all our inquiries (thank you), and we need your help now. We welcome any opportunity to meet with you, Meggan, Elizabeth, or whoever to ensure the Filing 2 Final Plat is approved ASAP. After 3+ years of working with <u>numerous</u> staff on Saddlehorn Ranch – from Rezoning and Preliminary Plans, to Development Plans, and now Final Plats (every application received <u>unanimous</u> BoCC approval) we are in the home stretch. The Final Plat for Filing 1 was relatively simple to get approved, but we just can't seem to get there with Filing 2. We know Saddlehorn Ranch is a large application, but it's frustrating and shouldn't be this complicated.

Thank you for your much-needed assistance.


