Please accept the following comments from El Paso County Public Health regarding the sand mining expansion project referenced above:

- Water and wastewater services were not specified or proposed as part of the expansion request. No structures are proposed on the site; therefore, the use of sanitary portable toilets can be approved due to the transition from area to area as the operation expands.
- Earthmoving activity in excess of one acre, but less than twenty-five acres, requires a local Construction Activity Permit from El Paso County Public Health. Earthmoving activities greater than 25 acres require a Construction Activity Permit from the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Air Pollution Control Division. Go to:

The proposed water quality detention basin that will capture diverted • flows and release storm water at historical rates into Brackett Creek must be designed to completely drain to help minimize mosquito breeding habitat and the potential for West Nile Virus.
