Thank you for getting in touch with me about the Wildlife Report that was not seen before the CPW comments were made. I have looked at your email with the attached Wildlife Report and associated emails regarding PMJM and other wildlife.

After reading the Wildlife Report and associated emails CPW concurs with the USFWS and the US Army Corps of Engineers that the activities and actions associated with the development will “not likely to adversely affect” PMJMs in the surrounding area.
