In reference to your correspondence dated May 25, 2021, "Waterview II Metro District Service Plan Amendment", file number ID212, described as "Major Amendment to a service plan under current model- From 40 mills to 65 mills" a request by the firm White Bear Anakele, Tanaka and Watson, and Anna Cherubin, who serve as general counsel to Waterview II Metropolitan District generally located at the southeast corner of the Powers and Bradley Road in El Paso County, Colorado.

Widefield School District #3 understands the cost increase of materials and inflation from the original Waterview II service plan from 2006. However, an increase of mills from 40 to 65 for this development will adversely affect Widefield School District #3 when we need to ask our voters for a bond to build new schools due to our increasing student population. Higher taxes may prevent our voters from passing a bond issue for needed schools.
