Please accept the following updated comments from El Paso County Public Health (EPCPH) regarding the project referenced above:

- Water service will be provided by Widefield Water and Sanitation District PWSID # CO0121900 which is a Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment approved community water and wastewater treatment facility. There is a finding for sufficiency in terms of water quality for Widefield Water and Sanitation District.
- Wastewater service will be provided by Widefield Water and Sanitation
 District. The Widefield Water and Sanitation District does have sufficient
 treatment capacity for the proposed 4.32-acre, 44 residential lot development.
 See the 07Feb2023 Letter of Commitment from Widefield Water and Sanitation
 District for both water and wastewater services.
- El Paso County Public Health encourages planned walkability of residential communities. Please consider appropriate connections to commercial areas through the use of sidewalks, and bike trails. Walkability features help reduce obesity and associated heart diseases.
- Earthmoving activity more than one acre, but less than twenty-five acres, requires a local Construction Activity Permit from El Paso County Public Health. Go to https://www.elpasocountyhealth.org/service/air-quality/construction-activity-application for more information.
- The water quality basin must have mosquito control responsibilities included as a part of the construction design and maintenance plan to help control mosquito breeding habitat and minimize the potential for West Nile Virus.
