Subject: Crossroads Chapel site changes

Good Afternoon,

It was nice to finally connect with you regarding your property and the proposed changes. El Paso County Public Health currently has records showing 1 building tied into an OWTS on this property. However, it is my understanding that currently there are 3 additional modular also connected to the OWTS that we do not have record of.

Based on our conversation, you are wanting to remove the modular units and build a new building to support the removal of the modular. During this process it is your intent to annex only the utilities including water and wastewater to be provided by a sanitation district in place of continued OWTS and Well water use. El Paso County Public Health has no objection to you connecting both buildings on the property to the central utility district in the area.

The OWTS as existing can remain in place and use until you are able to connect your buildings to the sanitation district. After you have made a successful connection to the wastewater main line EPCPH will require the OWTS system to be appropriately abandon as required by the Chapter 8 Regulations. It is recommended to contact a [licensed installer](#) to perform the system abandonment, which requires pumping and crushing of the tank. Additionally, you will need to complete the [Change Request Form](#) specifically the system abandonment and connection to sanitation district sections. This form must be submitted to HEASepticinfo@elpasoco.com upon completion of connection to sanitation and abandonment of the OWTS.
